

## 2021 Castagna Un Segreto

Un Segreto moves with a kind of quiet confidence — unhurried, unbothered by fashion, and deeply anchored in its own identity. As a blend of Sangiovese and Syrah, it carries both heritage and adaptation, but in 2021 the two varieties feel less like components and more like a single voice, speaking fluently of place.

The aromatics are immediately compelling, though never overstated. There is a beguiling perfume of red cherry and dried herbs, edged with subtle earth and lifted by fine spice. It draws you in gently, revealing itself in layers rather than declarations. There's a natural harmony here — nothing sits apart, everything feels considered.

On the palate, the wine is defined by its line and energy. Medium-bodied, it leans into brightness and precision, with a vivid thread of acidity that gives the wine its shape and forward motion. The tannins are firm yet refined, powdery in texture, providing structure without heaviness. They frame the fruit rather than overshadow it.

Fruit expression remains restrained — held in check by the architecture of the wine — allowing savoury notes and a quiet mineral edge to come through. It's a wine built on tension rather than weight, where the interplay between freshness and structure creates both interest and longevity.

With air, Un Segreto opens gradually, revealing further detail and nuance. It's not immediate, but patient — rewarding those who give it time in the glass.

A composed and expressive wine, where Sangiovese brings its brightness and structure, Syrah its depth and perfume — together forming something complete, balanced, and enduring.

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
